

Governor of Lemhannas RI Discusses Geopolitics of Defense Industry Raw Materials at KKIP Expert Team FGD

JAKARTA - Governor of Lemhannas RI, Andi Widjajanto, was present as a speaker at the Focus Group Discussion (FGD) with the title "Synchronization of Upstream-Downstream Needs and Policies to Increase the Contribution of the Aluminum Industry in Fulfilling the Need for Defense and Security Equipment" held by the Expert Team of the Defense Industry Policy Committee (KKIP) on Friday (25/8) virtually.

The FGD which was moderated by KKIP expert staff for Standardization Training and Development, Dr. Ir. Teguh Haryono MBA., IPU., ASEAN Eng., ACPE., APEC Eng aimed to obtain information as input from various perspectives in accordance with their core competencies in order to develop regulations or mechanisms needed to empower the domestic aluminum industry.

Andi Widjajanto delivered his presentation with the theme "Geopolitics of Defense Industry Raw Materials". He emphasized

three points, namely global market character, global supply chain, and Indonesian industry dependence.

Furthermore, Andi Widjajanto said that aluminum is categorized a critical mineral with significant reserves. Aluminum has a strategic value for the national defense industry. However, the domestic aluminum industry ecosystem has not fully met the needs of the national defense industry. Therefore, securing supplies is a crucial aspect for the sustainability of the national defense industry.

Several other speakers were also present, including the Deputy of the Strategic Downstream Field at the Ministry of Investment/ **Investment Coordinating Board** (BKPM), Heldy Satrya Putera; Director of Retail and Commerce of PT. PLN, Edi Sri Mulyanti; and Operational Director of PT. Inalum, Rainaldy Harahap.

Lemhannas RI Holds FGD on the **Constitutionality of State Policy**

JAKARTA - Lemhannas RI, through the Directorate of Ideological and Political Studies of the Deputy Office for Strategic Studies, held a Focus Group Discussion (FGD) on Urgent and Quick Studies with the theme "Constitutionality of State Policy to Maintain the Sustainability of the National Development" on Monday (28/8), at the Fourth Floor of Kresna Room, Lemhannas RI.

"Today we will discuss the state policy, considering that Indonesia is actually projected by many institutions and intellects to become a power state in the world in 2050 even until 2075," Governor of Lemhannas RI, Andi Widjajanto, said.

Lemhannas RI believes that it is essential to research how state policy issuance would affect Indonesian state administration. The regulation for emergency conditions in the constitution which could implicate the process of changing the leadership of state institutions were also discussed in the FGD.

Andi Widjajanto emphasized the essential question about what must be prepared in 2045 and 2075. With the opinions of several speakers at the FGD, Andi Widjajanto hoped that it would result in enlightenment for the state's future development.

During the FGD that was moderated by Professional Expert in Geostrategy and National Resilience of Lemhannas RI.

Dr. Margaretha Hanita, S.H., M.Si., Chairman of the People's Consultative Assembly of the Republic of Indonesia (MPR RI), Dr. H. Bambang Soesatyo, S.E., S.H., M.B.A., was present as one of the speakers.

Bambang Soesatyo conveyed the urgency for a state policy. In essence, it starts from the need for directive principles that will clarify the normative principles in the constitution into basic state political policies as a guidance for the national development.

There were several other speakers present at the FGD, including the Chairman of the Regional Representative Council of the Republic of Indonesia (DPD RI), Ir. H. "We offer evidence that demonstrates that Indonesia's health system has no climate change-related legislation or policies," he explained.

RDP with Commission I DPR RI, Lemhannas RI Discusses RKA of 2024

JAKARTA - Governor of Lemhannas RI, Andi Widjajanto, accompanied by a number of Lemhannas RI officials attended the Hearing Meeting (RDP) with Commission I of the House of Representatives of the Republic of Indonesia (DPR RI), on Thursday (31/8), at the DPR RI Office Complex. The RDP agenda was the Lemhannas RI's Work Plan and Budget of 2024.

On this occasion, Andi Widjajanto explained a series of programs that would be implemented by Lemhannas RI for 2024 fiscal year. There are two main programs funded from the Lemhannas RI budget, namely the national resilience development program and the management support program.

For 2024 fiscal year, the national resilience development program has four agendas, namely national-level

leaders education, strengthening of national values, strategic studies, and national resilience measurement. Meanwhile, the management support program has six agendas, namely public relations service, cooperation and legal service, planning service, telematics service, supervision service, general affairs service, and employee expenditure.

Lemhannas RI also proposed new initiatives to promote the quality of the institution's performance. The details of the proposed new initiatives were aimed at the agenda of the Deputy Office for Strategic Studies, National Resilience Laboratory Center, Telematics Bureau, and General Affairs Bureau of the Prime Secretariat of Lemhannas RI. Aside from that, Lemhannas RI also submitted a proposal to rise the budget to support


the agendas of Strengthening of National Values for members of the DPR RI elected in the 2024 election.

On the same occasion, Andi Widjajanto emphasized the importance of digital transformation for Lemhannas RI involving software and hardware updates. "Lemhannas RI finds that in the next two or three years, learning methods will have to use digital methodology such as machine learning or artificial intelligence," he stated.

JAKARTA - Chair of the Audit Board of the Republic of Indonesia (BPK RI), Dr. Isma Yatun, CSFA., CFrA. had the opportunity to give a lecture to the participants of the Short Education Program Batch 24 (PPSA 24) with a presentation entitled "State Budget and Finance Accountability" on Monday (11/9), at Bhinneka Tunggal Ika Room, Third Floor of Pancagatra Building, Lemhannas RI.

"The realization of good governance actually starts from accountability, which includes public accountability," Isma Yatun stated starting her

presentation. The implementation of good governance in the budget cycle aims to ensure that government revenues and expenditures have been planned, implemented and accounted for properly and have been audited by an independent external audit institution.

Regarding external audits, BPK RI audits are the most important budget accountability mechanism in public financial management because publication of the results of BPK audits can increase transparency of the entire state financial management system. In

addition, the process of following up on BPK audit results by entities is a crucial factor for creating sustainable improvements in the quality of public financial management.

Dr. Isma expressed her wish while concluding her presentation that the knowledge and experience shared to PPSA 24 participants would be useful and serve as inspiration for them to keep improving and be more accountable in carrying out their duties and roles in their respective institutions.
