# Lemhannas RI holds Strengthening Personnel Capacity Program in entering the Industrial Era 4.0



**G**overnor of Lemhannas RI Lieut. Gen. (Ret.) Agus Widjojo opened Strengthening the Capacity of Lemhannas RI Personnel in entering the Industrial Era 4.0 on Monday (23/11) in Dwi Warna Purwa Room, Pancagatra Building, 1<sup>st</sup> Floor, Lemhannas RI.

In his remarks, Agus said that this program could be a means to develop personnel capacity as a driver of transformation that supports Indonesia in making a leap in the process of achieving the Roadmap for Making Indonesia 4.0 and sustainable development through collaborative action and innovative solutions.

It basically aims to increase the knowledge of Lemhannas RI personnel in understanding the Theory U process as a framework for designing and providing innovative transformation processes at both the individual and collective (organizational) levels with

the achievements of Head Intelligence, Hands Intelligence, and Heart Intelligence

In line with these objectives, the objectives of this program include strengthening intelligence in a comprehensive, holistic and integral manner in the learning process entering the Industrial Era 4.0; strengthening technical expertise, which is able to offer innovation in the creation of cross-sectoral learning systems and laboratories entering the Industrial Era 4.0; and strengthening emotional intelligence in transforming experience sharing and learning tools to improve the quality of learning in the learning process entering the Industrial Era 4.0.

Agus emphasized that this program was a means to develop the capacity of Lemhannas RI personnel. "Related to transformation to encourage change, so we must be familiar with change. Most of us

are still looking for a position that is comfortable with change," Agus said. Furthermore, Agus also said that in making the roadmap aspirations leap requires collaborative action.

Furthermore, Agus expressed his hope that the participants would gain beneficial knowledge to be applied to their respective work units at Lemhannas RI. "Precisely what is expected is that the material given can be understood by the participant and be able to be applied in the work unit at Lemhannas RI. I don't want to look at the strategic and global aspects, but more of individual changes in Lemhannas RI," Agus said.

The Strengthening the Personnel Capacity Program which was held in two batches, was attended by 100 participants consisting of one echelon I official, 17 echelon II officials, 29 echelon III officials, 52 echelon IV officials, and 1 staff.

# International Conference on Women, Peace and Inclusive Societies

**G**overnor of Lemhannas RI Lieut. Gen. (Ret.) Agus Widjojo gave a speech at the Opening Ceremony of the International Conference on Women, Peace and Inclusive Society “Building Grounded & Sustainable Peace: Women’s Experience in Post Conflict Situation and The Realm of Radicalism” in collaboration between Lemhannas RI and the National Commission on Anti Violence Against Women (Komnas Perempuan) on Thursday (26/11).

At the event that discussed the role of women in maintaining peace in order to strengthen national resilience, Agus Widjojo considered that the most important thing in maintaining a commitment to achieve gender equality and women’s empowerment was to continue to pay attention to women’s rights in development and peace.

On that occasion, Agus also conveyed that the call for women’s empowerment and protecting women’s rights was part of a global agreement as set out in the development agenda. The commitment made by all countries obliges the governments of all countries to take actions to promote and protect women’s rights, so that the spirit and visionary commitment embedded in every state policy will not vanished.

Agus emphasized that creating a policy that supports the role of women in the development process is a certainty. Women can enjoy their human rights as an international commitment and a precondition for wider cooperation in development, democracy, peace and security.

Meanwhile, the Chairperson of Komnas Perempuan Andy Yentriyani said that seeking recovery for women victims of conflict and supporting women’s leadership in building peace is a strategic step to support the

fulfillment of constitutional rights, especially in guaranteeing a sense of security, a life with dignity and free from discrimination on any basis. Andy further expressed his hope that the cooperation in organizing this international conference will continue by further institutionalizing a gender perspective in studies and education on national resilience.

The conference, which was held to commemorate 20 Years of UN Resolution 1325 and 16 Days of Violence Against Women (November 25- December 10, 2020), was attended by the Minister of Women’s Empowerment and Child Protection I Gusti Ayu Bintang Darmawati as the keynote speaker. In addition, there were five other speakers, namely International Expert on Transitional Justice Professor Fabian Savioli, Co-Founder and Executive Director of PAIMAN Alumni’s Trust, APWAP’s Affiliate Dr. Mossarat Nadim, Indonesian Representative for AICHR

Yuyun Wahyuningrum, Commissioner of Komnas Perempuan Prof. Dr. Alimatul Qibiyah, and Lecturer in Social and Cultural Affairs of Lemhannas RI Prof. Dr. Njaju Jenny Malik Toni Hardjatno.

the circumstances and substance of the material that reflect the developing situation, Olah Sismennas success can be viewed from several aspects, namely, the ability to analyze and anticipate developments in the situation. Second, adjustments to the right way of thinking and acting. Third, the level of integration in the analysis, policy formulation and its implementation by each Mayor, Regent and DPRD members in producing strategic and quality products. Fourth, integrated coordination and cooperation among Mayors, Regents and DPRD Members as well as other agencies being played is a logical illustration in an effort to mobilize the participation of all components of the nation in order to respond to the socio-cultural dynamics as a challenge to national security.

**A**s one of a series of activities from the Regional Leaders Strengthening Program Batch 11 (P3DA 11), P3DA 11 participants carried out a National Management System Simulation (Olah Sismennas) with the theme “Cross-Sector Coordination of Regional Government Apparatus and Vertical Agencies in Facing Disasters” starting November 30, 2020 until December 3 2020.

Olah Sismennas itself is one of the methods developed by Lemhannas RI in the teaching and learning process for P3DA participants and it was implemented at P3DA for the first time this year. This activity includes simulation exercises for cooperation, coordination and synchronization between institutions / agencies in producing and operating a government policy, so that national development policies aimed at improving people’s welfare can be carried out synergistically, effectively and

efficiently and bring maximum benefits for the community.

Governor of Lemhannas RI Lieut. Gen. (Ret.) Agus Widjojo believes that with the simulation of the policy formulation and decision-making processes in Olah Sismennas, participants can understand the dynamics of cross-sectoral coordination of local government officials and vertical agencies that involve various parties including accommodating various interests.

# Socialization on Staying Productive Strategy for Excellent ASN Post Pandemic

Lemhannas RI held a virtual socialization with the theme Staying Productive Strategy to Realize Excellent State Civil Aparatus (ASN) Post-Pandemic to Lemhannas RI personnel on Wednesday (2/12).

Chief of Cooperation and Legal Bureau of Lemhannas RI Commodore Sri Widodo, S.T., M.A.P. who opened the event, said that people are facing a new life style during the pandemic. "Changes in lifestyle that were initially real, suddenly changed completely into virtual world. The process of working in an office and studying at school must now be conducted at home. The same changes applied in communal prayers at places of worship because no one can be immune from corona virus," Sri Widodo said.

As a state servant, Sri Widodo reminded Lemhannas RI personnel not to be careless about the current changes in life. Furthermore, Sri Widodo reminded Lemhannas RI personnel to be responsible for maintaining the continuity of the implementation of the duties and functions of government administration, especially the duties of functions and work programs at Lemhannas RI.

Regarding the performance of ASN during the pandemic, the Deputy for Personnel Management Development at BKN RI Drs. Haryomo Dwi Putranto, M.Hum. as the speaker for the socialization explained that the performance management system during this pandemic was no different from the pre-pandemic period, but there was some emphasis on the civil servant performance management subsystem. "Changes in the dynamic strategic environment of the organization require



an adaptive performance management system," he said.

Then Haryomo also explained that there are eleven things that need to be considered in a performance management system. First, performance management is based on goals. Second, ensuring the alignment of organization, unit and individual employee goals. Third, conveying the role and contribution of employees in achieving organizational goals. Fourth, setting goals that meet the SMART principles; Fifth, clear targets (fulfilling the SMART principles) which improve employee performance and vice versa. Sixth, SMART: Specific, Measurable, Attainable, Realistic, and time-bounded.

Seventh, ensuring the clarity of indicators of employee work success, and conveying and encouraging employees to make it happen. Eighth, organizational goals must be aligned with organizational strategies and

goals in times of pandemic. Ninth, monitoring is followed up with intensive coaching, mentoring and counselling. Tenth, ensuring that the placement of employees is in accordance with their competencies and interests. Eleventh, recording the results of employee monitoring as material for performance appraisals at the end of the year.

With the conditions of the organization's environment changing rapidly, according to Haryomo, it is necessary to implement Talent Management which requires high-talented Human Resources (HR). This includes the recruitment of appropriate employees, both permanent and non-permanent, development of a culture of knowledge, effective performance management, enhancement of employee performance experience and optimization of strategies and HR planning.



After completing education, alumni will return to fully carry out their roles and authorities in their respective political positions as has become the experience of alumni. Agus emphasized the alumni's role in delivering and enforcing materials while at Lemhannas RI in the form of Basic Nation Consensus consisting of Pancasila, UUD NRI 1945 (the 1945 Constitution), NKRI (the Unitary State of the Republic of Indonesia), and the spirit contained in Bhinneka Tunggal Ika (Unity in Diversity). # The Governor of Lemhannas RI as speaker at the 66<sup>th</sup> Eminence Lecture Anniversary

**G**overnor of Lemhannas RI, Lieut. Gen. (Ret.) Agus Widjojo was presented as a speaker at the 66th Eminence Lecture Anniversary of the UPI FPIPS Civics Study Program with the theme "Revitalizing Nationalism During the Covid-19 Pandemic to Foster National Resilience" on Tuesday, December 8, 2020.

On his occasion, Agus said that Nationalism is a feeling of unity which is overwhelmed by the pride of his nation and state. Agus also explained that Nationalism is an understanding of nationality of the people of a state who have awareness and love for their nation and state shown through their attitudes and behaviour of each individuals or the people.

According to Agus, there are several objectives of Nationalism, including fostering and increasing love for the homeland and nation, building harmonious relationships among individuals and communities, building and strengthening brotherhood among fellow members of society, trying to eliminate extremism or excessive demands from citizens towards the government, fostering a spirit of self-sacrifice for the homeland and nation as well as protecting the homeland



and nation from any threats both from outside and within the country.

In the history of Indonesia, Agus saw Nationalism emerged from the elites of the nation who were educated and created the ideas of Nationalism. therefore, education has an important role. "without education, there will no awareness which makes it difficult for us to expect Nationalism awareness," Agus added.

The goal of nationalism in this era of globalization is not physically limiting between National and International, but it is manifested in the form of national interests. "For national interest, we have to interact at the global level, so we do that. In fact, there are many achievements made by the younger generation

in the international order and scope which have also brought the name of the country. That is aalso nationalism," Agus added.

National Resilience will be greatly affected by Covid-19, the source of the challenge of the Covid-19 problem actually lies in the Economic and Socio-Cultural aspects. "We will see, for example, in the economic aspects, with the number of layoffs and the weakening of the national economy," said Agus.

Covid-19 has two sides that cannot be separated, on the one hand, Covid-19 has health aspects that must be healed, on the other hand, it cannot be separated from the economic aspect as well. "This is a dilemma for policy makers. If we prioritize health first, the economy will gradually decline, likewise, if we pay attention to the economy aspect, it will risk our lives," Agus said.



# Lemhannas RI holds Reflections of Faculty Members on Teaching and Learning Process during the COVID-19 Pandemic



Lemhannas RI held a Reflection of Faculty Members on the Teaching and Learning Process during the COVID-19 Pandemic on Thursday (10/12) at Gajah Mada Auditorium of Lemhannas RI.

The program which lasted for two days, was opened by the Deputy Governor of Lemhannas RI, Air Marshal Wieko Syofyan. Wieko, who read the Governor of Lemhannas RI's speech, said that the existence of senior lecturers, senior analysts, professional experts, and structural officials, have an important and dominant role in supporting the success of education program.

Wieko emphasized that the same understanding and perception of faculty members regarding the operational mechanism of education during this pandemic situation will support the smooth and successful implementation of education programs.

In addition, Wieko hopes that all related elements will follow up on the results of this reflection seriously and responsibly according to their respective roles and functions.
