AUDIT FINDINGS OF BPK (STATE AUDIT BOARD) OF THE REPUBLIC OF INDONESIA IN RESPECT OF FINANCIAL STATEMENT OF LEMHANNAS RI OF 2009 AND OPENING OF SYMPOSIUM ON STABILIZATION OF FINANCIAL ACCOUNTABILITY AND PERFORMANCE

On June 8, 2010, the Governor of Lemhannas RI, Prof. DR. Muladi, S.H., received submission of audit findings of BPK-RI (State Audit Board) of the Republic of Indonesia in respect of financial statement of Lemhannas of fiscal year of 2009 in Dwi Warna Purwa Building of Lemhannas RI.

Based on audit findings of BPK-RI, Lemhannas RI earns opinion of Reasonable Without Exception (WTP) in respect of financial statement of fiscal year of 2009. It recurs the previous achievement in respect of financial statement of fiscal year of 2007 and 2008 which also earned the predicate of WTP. Evaluation findings on report of Government Agency Performance Accountability (LAKIP), Lakip of Lemhannas RI in 2009 has, by the Ministry for Supervision of State Apparatus and Bureaucracy Reformation, been ranked 15 out of 74 agencies evaluated from planning, measurement, reporting, evaluation and performance achievement aspect. This achievement proves that budget management of Lemhannas RI has already had appropriate level of compliance with the prevailing legislation, and application of internal control system has run effectively, efficiently and productively. There is no manipulative and material misrepresentation in Budget and financial management. Recording and financial statement already fulfills the government accounting standard and adequacy of evidence in data exposure.

After submission of audit findings of BPK-RI, the session was continued with symposium attended by officials and all members of Lemhannas RI having a theme of **"Stabilization of Financial Accountability and Performance in the Framework of Bureaucracy Reformation of Lemhannas RI"**.

In his welcoming remarks, the Governor of Lemhannas RI said among others that the success of Lemhannas RI in the program and budget management manifested in financial report accountability and LAKIP is hardworking result of all members of Lemhannas RI and also cannot be separated from development and direction from relevant agencies such as BPK, BPKP and others through various forum in terms of Symposium, workshop, examination, guidance, and coordination as well as consultancy.

By performing bureaucracy reformation, financial accountability and performance of Lemhannas RI keeps increasing, so that existence of Lemhannas RI as superior agency could be materialized.

In the bureaucracy reformation process, the thing that needs attention is that the form of participation as source of power and motivator the establishment of cooperation to create the best performance, since effectiveness and successfulness of bureaucracy reformation will mostly depend on concern and participation of all members of Lemhannas RI.

In this respect, the Governor appeals that the member of Lemhannas RI makes desire for participation a central point of mindset and culture in organizing daily social, national or state life.

NATIONAL SEMINAR OF LEMHANNAS ALUMNI ASSOCIATION (IKAL) OF THE REPUBLIC OF INDONESIA

A s one of manifestations of concern both in state and national life, the Lemhannas Alumni Association (IKAL) of the Republic of Indonesia organized National Seminar having the theme of **“Trying to Find Format of National Security System in Democracy and Globalization Era”** on June 22-23, 2010 in Dwiwarna Building. The event lasting for 2 (two) days was opened by President of the Republic of Indonesia, DR. H. Susilo Bambang Yudhoyono, by inviting speakers such as Coordinating Minister for Politics and Security, Coordinating Minister for Economy, Minister of Defense, Chief Commander of the Indonesian National Armed Forces, National Police Chief, Governor of Lemhannas RI, Vice Minister of Defense, Vice Chairperson of People’s Consultative Assembly of the Republic of Indonesia (MPR RI), Head of Legislation Body of the People’s House of Representatives (DPR

RI), Vice Chairperson of Commission I of DPR RI, Vice Chairperson of Provincial House of Representatives of the Republic of Indonesia, Politicians and Academicians.

This Seminar of Lemhannas Alumni Association of the Republic of Indonesia has become very important and strategic forum, and also become academic forum with the spirit of nationality and loving for country which is heterogenic, due to engaging academic, practitioner, bureaucratic official elements in wide scope, and other public elements indicating manifestation of concern about the future of Indonesia which indeed becomes mutual responsibility.

This seminar adopts 4 (four) topics namely: **first**, Political consensus and Philosophical principle of Defense and Security System in the 1945 Constitution of the Republic of Indonesia; **second**,

Perspective of National Security System in the framework of National Interest; **third**, National Security System and Perspective of All Bases of State and National Life; and **fourth**, National Security System in International Interaction and Operational Perspective.

Basic concept of national security is based on sovereignty and basic value of Indonesia, namely, loving for peace, but more loving for freedom. Indonesia needs to maintain and stabilize legitimacy of state, own and maintain identity, as well as build competitiveness capacity of state to survive for good. As Board of management of IKAL, the Governor of Lemhannas RI said that, national security approach should take into account geo-political and geo-strategic dimension and key position in Asia Pacific Regional Community. And it is certainly with assumption which is quite understandable such as level of development of threat which getting increased.

In the framework of approach to find format of national security system, it should be acknowledged that Indonesia needs a socio-engineering process together with society in maintaining, prioritizing, and encouraging national interest as main consideration for every step taken in building this country, and establishment of legislation for national security system is considered very important with preparatory phases of agreement in respect of concept, assumption and national security strategy.

PREPAREDNESS OF PHLN PROJECT OF LEMHANNAS RI AND SIGNING OF CONTRACT AMENDMENT

Tuesday, July 13, 2010, the Foreign Donation Project (PHLN) Team of Lemhannas RI submitted report on preparedness of the project to the Governor of Lemhannas RI in Nusantara I, Trigata Building. Ir. Kurdinanto Sarah, M.Sc as Coordinator of ICT Ad hoc team of Lemhannas RI and as part in charge of PHLN Project said that: in the framework of financial cooperation program between Indonesia – Spain, Lemhannas RI and CIMSA (Spain) have signed contract agreement No. 01/II/2008 on February 28, 2008 for project of “**Strengthening the capacity Building of the National Resilience Institute of the Republic of Indonesia**”, consisting of design, development, and integrated management information system installation for Lemhannas RI. In reference to existence of interval from agreement contract through the present time, adjustment of scope of project has been made in various aspects to fulfill current technical need in Lemhannas RI, and to ensure integration with infrastructure and system bought or developed by Lemhannas RI.

Further, Lemhannas RI, in cooperation with CIMSA, has conducted a comprehensive survey to map current ICT condition of Lemhannas at present and make detail identification of technical need of infrastructure, system development, training, and so on. The above identification has been summarized in needs in the master plan of ICT of Lemhannas RI, functioning as roadmap and indicator on

Brigadier General of Police, DR. HM. Said Saile, M.Si, the Head of General Affairs Bureau as Commitment Maker Official (PPK) on the occasion has reported on status of process toward the effective contract of contract amendment process to the Governor of Lemhannas RI, the entire contract value is EUR 7,390,093, the financing thereof is made through soft loan scheme “mixed credit” (150% of Development Aid Fund, and 50% of Export Credit).

In this respect, the Governor of Lemhannas RI conveyed some directions: **first**, Transfer of Knowledge should be made appropriately, **second**, engage all potential human resources existing in Lemhannas RI; **third**, assist and support all project activities optimally; **fourth**, Sense Of Belonging and Tense of Security should be owned by all parties; **fifth**, cooperation in the implementation plan, and should be established optimally so that the entire projects will be successful. As a follow-up of report on preparedness of the said PHLN project, on Wednesday, July 14, 2010 at 1.30 PM, a signing of Contract Amendment of PHLN project of Lemhannas RI was made in Meeting Room of Nusantara I, Trigatra Building witnessed by the First Secretary of Lemhannas RI, DR. Ardi Partadinata, together with heads of Bureaus, Directors and other invitees.

VISIT OF DELEGATION OF CIVIL SOCIETY OF MYANMAR TO LEMHANNAS RI

Visit of delegation of civil society from Myanmar of 13 (thirteen) persons accompanied by 2 (two) representatives from Friedrich Ebert Stiftung (FES) on June 15, 2010 to Lemhannas RI was welcomed in Meeting Room of Nusantara I. Delegation chaired by Mr. Khim Zaw Win is aimed at Audience to the Governor of Lemhannas RI, Prof. Dr. Muladi, S.H., being one of National figures experiencing and continuing political transition in Indonesia after 1998 (senior figure in new order and reformation era).

Myanmar is a country commencing its transition earlier than Indonesia, but democracy in Myanmar is still far left behind if compared to Indonesia that has become the most democratic country in Southeast Asia. Based on the reason, the delegation from civil society of Myanmar intends to learn the democratic transition process in Indonesia, since from 1998 through 2010 Indonesia is considered to be successful in performing the democratization process or in maintaining the unitary state of Indonesia.

Burma has been reigned by military regime since 1962, so that demonstration act by students of Myanmar in 1988 was on the contrary responded by violence by the incumbent

regime.

The world society act to isolate the country and impose sanction has not in fact shown result as expected. However, recently, there is tendency of movement in political constellation through Seven-Stage Plan, a form of government which is constitutional, by adoption of new constitution on May 2008, and it is planned that the National General Election will be held in 2010.

Myanmar has historical relation which is closely enough with Indonesia started from good relationship between the President Soekarno and U Nu, the First Prime Minister of Burma in those days. In addition to the historical relationship, Burma and Indonesia have also many things in common in politics, social and culture, since the two countries are multi-ethnic country. In Indonesia, the difference of ethnics can be resolved appropriately due to existence of national ideology of Pancasila and motto of Unity in Diversity, however, it is different from Myanmar that the difference of ethnics has on the contrary become destabilization factor.

In Myanmar, balanced civil-military relation is still expectation. To that end, placement of the two parties in parliament is the initial step to improve the civil-military relationship.

In the near future, Myanmar will hold a general election, but it cannot change the condition of Myanmar all at once. However, the general election will be the initial step of political transition of Myanmar. The visitors have, through meeting with the Governor of Lemhannas, explored phases upon political transition process in Indonesia. Therefore, explanation of Governor of Lemhannas RI will be very valuable lesson to Myanmar.

In the end of session, the Governor of Lemhannas conveyed his impression and message to the delegation of Myanmar that in addition to learn from democratic transition process in Indonesia, the Myanmar people should be united in watching the democratic transition process occurring in Myanmar, and cooperate with the other civil society. In the history of its establishment, military in Indonesia has strong root in Indonesian people, so that no significant difficulty has been encountered to release political function or engagement in economic sector. In addition to removal of dual-functions of Indonesian National Armed Forces, the ministry of defense of the Republic of Indonesia is also chaired by civil person.

Indonesia will, in its non-aligned diplomatic role in ASEAN territory, always assist the democratization process in Myanmar, and simultaneously invite participants from Myanmar country to participate in PPRA education in Lemhannas RI.

The session was closed at 12.00 AM. Before leaving Lemhannas RI, the delegation of Myanmar took pictures with the Governor, Vice Governor and the other officials of Lemhannas RI.

The visit was initiated with courtesy call by 3 (three) representatives of CDSS of Australia together with Assistant to Attaché of Defense of Australia to the Governor of Lemhannas RI accompanied by Air Vice Marshal (Ret.) Surya Dharma, S.IP, and Head of Public Relations. Further, discussion session was held in Asta Gatra Building, Floor III West, attended by 12 (twelve) persons of participants of PPRA XLIV and accompanied by Major General (Ret.) Pandji Susilo, Ir. Timotius D. Harsono and Head of Public Relations.

Discussion activity is chaired by Air Vice Marshal (Ret.) Surya Dharma S.IP with explanation topic of Australia entitled **What should the Obama Administration be Doing to Increase Efforts to Counter Terrorism.**

Meanwhile, the participants of PPRA XLIV Lemhannas RI state the topic of **What Indonesia Expects from the Obama Administration in Terms of the World's Prosperity and Security.** The discussion activity and question-answer session run enthusiastically. The respective party gives many questions and opinions in relation to military policy of the United States of America, the government of Barack Obama as well as its influence to Indonesia.

To Indonesia that has several times suffered from criminal act of terrorism killing life of innocent people, terrorism is a real war. Since there is no country which is immune from the threat of terrorism, it is necessary to establish inter-states cooperation in the effort to overcome the said terrorism act.

In addition to threat of terrorism, discussion also relates to global issue that should be encountered by the world, including Indonesia, in the future among others consisting of climate change, scarcity of energy, food and others. However the food crisis issue is not

something to worry about by Indonesia, since its demographic position has made it possible for Indonesia to be the one of food centers. At present time, Indonesia should, in addition to encounter the issue of terrorism, also immediately overcome the issue of poverty, insurrection, corruption, illegal logging, law mafia and many other problems requiring immediate handling.

Indonesia is of the opinion that in the discussion, the United States of America has double standard in the application of human rights. It results in negative sentiment and anger against the United States of America among the Indonesian people. In a good relationship, the United States of America should understand Indonesia, as Indonesia understands the role and interest of the United States of America.

The discussion summarizes that terrorism is an ideological issue triggered by social gap, such as poverty and low level of education. Therefore, the issue of terrorism is international issue that should be resolved together.

The session was ended at 12.00 AM and was closed with taking pictures with delegation of Australian Defence College-Centre for Defence and Strategic Studies and officials of Lemhannas RI and participants of PPRA XLIV in front of Asta Gatra Building.

ACCELERATION OF POLITICAL EDUCATION PROCESS IN INDONESIA

Complexity of issue in social, state and national life requires leader having excellent quality not only in intellectual intelligence but also in social, emotional and spiritual intelligence. In this democracy era, the leader is faced by demand for change of all life sectors leading to advancement of state, not only able to give vision, inspiration, and spirit. The Leader needs to possess significant capability of processing democracy practice which is now indicating pragmatic political phenomenon and far from the spirit of nationalism. One of phenomenon developing at present time is that every citizen shall be entitled to be engaged in political process. The impact is outstanding, namely people feel free to use their political rights optimally particularly freedom in determining choice and opportunity to nominate themselves as leader. The consequence is that dilemma in the selection process of leadership relating to capability of leader as required to resolve state issues.

Since complexity of issue in social, state and national life, then the Directorate of Political Research of Deputy of Strategic Research of Lemhannas RI, on Tuesday, July 6, 2010 organized a Round Table Discussion (RTD) in the Meeting Room of Nusantara I, Trigatra Building with a theme of **“Acceleration of Political Education Process in Indonesia to Prepare Regeneration of Professional Leader Cadres In the Framework of Supporting National Development Process”**. The RTD was opened by keynote speech of the Governor of Lemhannas RI, readout by Vice Governor of Lemhannas RI, Air Chief Marshal DR. Rio Mendung Thalieb. This great theme having strategic meaning taking into account various problems in cadre formation influencing survival of

national development process.

With system adopted at the moment, Indonesia suffers from various hindrances to obtain leader pursuant to state condition. It is understandable, due to non-establishment of format of cadre formation of leader which is ideal to a country which is plural such as Indonesia. Meanwhile, Indonesia needs “excellent leader” in the meaning, fulfilling ideal criteria of a leader, added by special capability to processing diversity. With low level of human resources quality but ample natural resources, the leader requires character enrichment process of moral and capability aspect, so that it will, even without indoctrination, refer to objective of state continuously which will be certainly relevant until 35 years namely upon 1 (one) century of Independence of the Republic of Indonesia.

Round Table Discussion expectedly discusses some solutions that will be jointly built such as: first, making political education program aiming at educating people to understand and instill their political rights and obligation as citizen, the compulsory program of the government, KPU (General Election Commission) and political party; second, giving revision suggestion toward the law on political party aiming at requiring political party to do screening and preparation of cadre as early as possible through the process which is really democratic, fair and is based on justice; third, increasing participation of media to change standpoint of people on instantaneous interest particularly free to participate in political process which is expensive, and can simultaneously insist the political parties not to function party as “leased vehicle” with expensive price in the nomination of public official.

Stabilization of State Values, National Conception, and Leadership is a part of democracy consolidation. Principally, this stabilization is an effort to give illumination dialogically with material being the core subject of Lemhannas. The Governor of Lemhannas RI, represented by Vice Governor of Lemhannas RI opened the event on June 28, 2010 in Dwiwarna Building. Participants of Adeksi of Group XXIV originating from Regional Government Official, Leader, and Member of Provincial Parliament throughout Indonesia.

Referring to state basis and quality of national resilience, the Governor quotes the speech as conveyed by the President of the Republic of Indonesia, Susilo Bambang Yudhoyono in the celebration of Pancasila's Anniversary on June 1, 2010, "Pancasila is already pronounced 65 years ago by Bung Karno, as founder of this country, but values as contained therein are still relevant to state and national life up to present"

Pancasila concept as state basis should certainly base every national and state life, namely the concept of work together in mutual cooperation, democracy with deliberation and representative, as well as nationalism closely cooperating with

the other country. However, violence, terrorism, radicalism, or separatism acts which still occur at present is threat and may affect the quality of national resilience of Indonesia. "they all may become threat and accumulate thereby requiring immediate handling. It constitutes state issue that should be jointly taken into account to find the best formula in handling the same in order not to spread to the other region" said the Governor. All state components play significant role in increasing the sense of togetherness which is solid based on state values which is important as national power.

From the stabilization activity, the Governor expected that the participants are able to **first**, think systematically, comprehensively and integrally for national interest in the framework of NKRI (Unitary State of the Republic of Indonesia); **second**, encouraging anticipative, cooperative attitude and synergized with the interest of people, **third**, being concern about the potency owned by region and developing independence of region, as well as commitment to survival of national development securing tranquility and orderliness of society as well as prosperity of people.

VISIT OF THE GOVERNOR OF LEMHANNAS RI TO THE UNITED KINGDOM IN THE FRAMEWORK OF PPRA XLIV

The governor of Lemhannas RI as Chairperson of Delegation of Overseas Strategic Studies accompanied by Secretary of Governing Board of Lemhannas RI, Major General (Ret.) Albert Inkiriwang and the First Secretary of Lemhannas RI, Dr. Ardi Partadinata, in his speech lasting for approximately 1 hour attended by among others the Foreign Ministry of the United Kingdom, London School of Economy and Political Science (LSE), 25 (twenty five) participants of PPRA XLIV, and 7 (seven) officials of Lemhannas RI.

The Governor of Lemhannas RI said that the National Resilience Concept developed by Indonesia is currently already adopted by ASEAN. It relates to more important role of Lemhannas RI in encouraging Regional Resilience of ASEAN, so that currently the National Resilience Concept is under the development process toward the Regional Resilience through ASEAN Social Political Community.

Further, the Governor of Lemhannas RI conveyed information on Indonesia's experience in building National Resilience. That National Resilience of Indonesia was built through various aspects of National Resilience as owned, such as Geography, Demography, Natural Assets, including ideological, political, economic, socio-cultural, Defense and Security aspects. All of them refer to Comprehensive Security concept containing State Security and Human Security. To that end, the national

The Governor of Lemhannas further said that the National Resilience of Indonesia is defensive, less militaristic and inward looking in nature. In other words, the National Resilience can be interpreted as capability to recover from unexpected condition; having capability of engineering resilience, namely capability of state to be able to get rid of crisis, thereby being able to restore to normal situation; Ecological Resilience; namely capability of state to adopt and adapt the positive change of development; Anticipatory Resilience, namely capability in rationalize, predict,

and anticipate various challenges and change in the future.

In the question-answer session, the material covers around the National Resilience Concept of Indonesia; The future of ASEAN integration in responding to regional issue, Human Rights Issue, Low Carbon Economy (Climate Change), and Threat to National Resilience of Indonesia.

The said SSLN activity was not only filled with Lecture of the Governor in Chatham House, but also made some visits to some Institutions and the United Kingdom Ministry, such as the Ministry of Defense, Ministry of Foreign Affairs, and some Strategic Industries in the United Kingdom.

STABILIZATION OF NATIONALITY VALUES, FOR YOUNG GENERATION OF GROUP II OF 2010

Stabilization of state values as the part of and basis of democratic consolidation cannot principally be left to natural process which is full of turbulence, but it shall be systematic and dialogic effort to participants with materials becoming the core subject of Lemhannas RI that should be understood by every participant, so that the participants will be able to: **first**, think systematically and integral comprehensively for national interest in the framework of

Unitary of the State of the Republic of Indonesia; **second**, growing anticipative, cooperative, synergetic attitude toward the people's interest; **third**, able to explore self-potency thereby becoming tough youth with high fighting spirit and concern about state problem and give contribution in all life aspects; **fourth**, concern about potency owned by region and develop regional independency as well as committed to survival of national development securing tranquility and orderliness of people as well as people's prosperity.

In the end of his welcoming speech, the Governor of Lemhannas RI expected that all participants of Stabilization of State Values for Youth Peers are serious in participating in each of this short activity, namely being more Conscientious to see the material substance according to time allocation as already given, so that phase by phase of activity can give advantage optimally and can be performed according to position of participants in the middle of society.
