He asserted that the values contained in the *Bhineka Tunggal Ika* (Unity in Diversity) should have been a model for the world.

# Consolidation Forum Batch IV of the Head of Regional Government, Regent, Mayor, and Speaker of Regional People's House of Representatives of Regency/Municipality

One implementation of the roles of Lemhannas RI in preparing and stabilizing national level leadership is by organizing Consolidation Forum (Forkon) of Batch IV for Head of Regional government, Regent, Mayor, and speaker of DPRD of Regency/Municipality. Forkon was opened by Governor of Lemhannas RI, Prof.DR. Muladi, S.H., on October 19, 2010 in Dwiwarna Purwa Building and was attended by a total of 34 participants consisting of 10 regents, 5 deputy regents, 6 mayors, 8 speakers of the regency people's house of representative and 5 speakers of municipality people's house of representatives .

The Governor of Lemhannas RI, Prof. DR. Muladi, S.H., has, in his welcoming speech, said that the task of Lemhannas RI is stabilizing the leadership in order to have a comparative and competitive superiority and own strategic capability in anticipating

and handling any crisis. "The Consolidation Forum of Batch IV in particular is expected to be able to solve any issues as encountered in region, which, among others, include: State disintegration, multi-dimensional crisis, environment, demand for being more democratic, unemployment, poverty and disaster handling," said the Governor.

Participants of Forkon is expected to fulfill reformation demand and try to find problem solution either in the area of politics, economy, and law. The Governor sees that the situation encountered by Indonesia at present, has a high potential to threaten state integrity. Movements which are driven by group, ethnical, racial, religious interest, and etc should be monitored thoroughly and comprehensively.

In encountering strong current of globalization influence, the implementation of national development requires resilience condition of the respective

areas and can expectedly create stabilized national resilience condition. To that end, it is necessary to make any effort of understanding and instilling of national insight as directional guidelines and national resilience conception as determining factor of scope, volume, and intensity of development in region in the framework of national development comprehensively and integrally.

## HUMAN TRAFFICKING HANDLING TO MAINTAIN STATE DIGNITY

According to data of the United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime (UNODC), most of trafficked humans come from from 127 countries; they are exploited to 137 countries. The number of human trafficking for working and sexual exploitation in Indonesia is categorized as high, namely 3,785 victims who are mostly women and children. Human trafficking victims from Indonesia are trafficked for sexual and work exploitation in Malaysia, Singapore, Brunei Darussalam, Taiwan, Japan, Hong Kong, or Middle East. Indonesia also becomes the country of destination for human trafficking originating from the People's Republic of China (RRC), Thailand, Hong Kong, Uzbekistan, the Netherlands, Poland, Venezuela, Spain, and Ukraine.

State development toward a more dignified position is the goal of all countries. Therefore, a Roundtable Discussion was held with a theme of "The Handling of Human Trafficking to maintain State Dignity within Regional Environment in the Framework of National Resilience" and was

opened by Vice Governor of Lemhannas RI, Air Marshal DR. Rio Mendung Thalieb on October 19, 2010 in Nusantara I Room. The Round Table Discussion (RTD) was also attended by Vice Governor of West Java Province, Dede Yusuf, who gave his viewpoint relating to high rate of trafficking in West Java.

Trafficking in general is defined as "trading with illegal connotation", which means human trading. Human exploitation constitutes crucial thing of which it could be in the forms of sexual exploitation, compulsory working, slavery, sales of organs of body, and many others.

It has even entered into domain of

modern slavery that makes humans as trafficking commodity and put economic

value on human life. In fact, to some parties it has become a potential business, through utilization of sophisticated technology.

Modernization has resulted in prosperity and security gap which trigger any kind of various transnational crimes either committed by individuals or organized groups.

Human trafficking has significant social impact against state and national life. The susceptibility of people to economic difficulty, low level of education, susceptibility of family and community values to global influence, as well as "agents (syndicates) that see human trafficking as a potential business opportunity have made the handling measures more complex.

The complexity of human trafficking problem requires synergy between institution and stakeholder in the effort of avoidance, protection, rehabilitation, and social reintegration, as well as legal certainty which is able to indict the "syndicates" thereof and it has become one of solution keys to the problems.

Nowadays, the government has adopted various comprehensive steps in an effort to handle and minimize the human trafficking through cooperation with various NGOs and international organizations.

## IMPROVEMENT OF STATE INSIGHT FOR YOUNG GENERATION

Young generation who will continue national development for people's prosperity, taking into account the importance of role of young generation for Indonesia, Directorate of political Research held Roundtable Discussion entitled: "Improving State Insight for young generation) to strengthen Unity of State in the framework of maintaining the integrity of the Unitary State of the Republic of Indonesia (NKRI) on October 20, 2010 in Nusantara Room. The RTD was opened by the Governor of Lemhannas RI, Prof. DR. Muladi, S.H., and was attended by the State Minister of Youth

and Sports, Andi Alfian mallarangeng, as resource person.

Journey of Indonesian history has recorded role of young generation in momentum of state struggle, starting from the period of National Awakening in 1908, Youth Pledge in 1928, independence struggle in 1945, establishment of New Order in 1966, until reformation movement in 1998. The youth has high bargaining position which is proven through history certainty such as in speech of Bung Karno in Indonesia Raya Congress in Surabaya in 1931:

“Give me one thousand of elderly people, I could, together with them, relocate Mount Semeru. But, if 10 youths with high spirit and love their home country and nation are brought to me, then I could shock the world.”

Nowadays, the world requires youths who are visionary and having state insight as the part of “nation and character building”. Youth character with strong state insight is proven to have saved Indonesia from balkanization process, namely situation in which a certain multi-cultural country is divided into small countries that are hostile to each other.

“After reformation in 1998, youth movement tends to follow democratic substance putting priority to human rights including freedom to think. The motto of independence enlivened youth movement

in short-period,” said Governor. Issue as encountered by youth people at present is that establishment of character as succeeding generation, this process becomes difficult due to weak coordination and integration as the result of many Central and Regional Agencies/institutions that are involved and concerned. In relation to the “nation and character building”, there are some issues as contained in the initial idea thereof. First, independence; second; democracy; third, national unity; and fourth, international dignity. It was a manifestation of sovereignty as independent and united nation in order to get a recognition from the international world.

In order to build a nation with a strong character and civilization, good and

competitive human resources are needed. The instilling of national insight to build a strong, competitive and dignified character of Pancasila through planned character building is also required so that they will love their state and nation more.

## INCREASE OF ROLE OF NATIONAL ARMED FORCES IN MILITARY OPERATION OTHER THAN WAR IN THE FRAMEWORK OF SUCCESSFUL DEVELOPMENT

**R**oundtable discussion with the theme of Increase of Role of National Armed Forces in Military Operation other than War to strengthen Defense and Security system of whole People in the framework of successful development was convened on October 21, 2010 in Lemhannas RI in meeting room of Nusantara I, Trigatra Building of Lemhannas RI. The session was attended by the Minister of Defense, Prof. DR. Ir. Purnomo Yusgiantoro, M.Sc. and a number of officials of Lemhannas RI.

One of directions, phases and priorities of long-term development as contained in Chapter IV of Law of RI No.17 of 2007 regarding long-term development plan of 2005-2025 is the materialization of feeling of safety and peace to all people as well as maintenance of the integrity of the territory of the unitary state of Indonesia and sovereignty of state from any threat either domestically or internationally.

National Armed Forces as the state defense apparatus having capability and power can actively play its role to help government to overcome any existing problem through implementation of operation task other than war. To that end, there are some points that should be paid attention, they are among others: first, establishing or revising legislation in relation to implementation of main task of National Armed Forces; second, increasing

coordination among government agency that is in charge of state defense and security function; third, increasing development of people in relation to implementation of defense and security system of whole people; fourth, giving confirmation of interpretation which is clear and democratic regarding the meaning of “political policy and decision of state”, and fifth, necessity to immediately establish national security board having clear legal basis.

Judicially, the National Armed Forces (TNI) should actively play its role in performing its tasks including military operation other than war as described in the above. However, in implementation thereof, most of them could be performed optimally. The condition is due to existence of Article 7 Paragraph (3) of Law of RI No. 34 of 2004 regarding National Armed Forces

(TNI) stating that “provisions as referred to in paragraph (2) shall be performed based on state political policy and decision’.

Meanwhile the political condition at present is very dynamic, and tends not to reflect high commitment or consistent to maximize the main task of National Armed Forces particularly through military operation other than war.

In his keynote speech, the Governor of Lemhannas RI, Prof. DR. Muladi, S.H., states that increase of task of National Armed Forces in military operation other than war to strengthen defense and security system of whole people should be based on national interest so that it can further reflect harmonization and synchronization either in policy level or operation phase.

# GOVERNOR INTERACTIVE DIALOGUE

**T**he Governor of Lemhannas RI, Prof. DR. Muladi, S.H., appeared in the interactive dialogue session in TVRI as the main resource person with the theme of “one year reflection and performance achievement of Lemhannas RI” on October 20, 2010. The dialogue program was attended also by a professor of IPB, Prof. DR. Bomer Pasaribu and a Member of Commission I of People’s House of Representatives (DPR RI), DR. Hj. R. Adjeng Ratna Suminar, S.H., M.M., as co-resource persons.

In the beginning of conversation, the Governor explained that based on President Regulation No.67 of 2006, Lemhannas RI has the following functions: **first**, as Center for Training of National Level Leader either from the National Armed Forces (TNI), National Police, Civil Society, Mass Organization, Political Organization, and public figures; **second**, as the strategic research institution of which findings are then forwarded to President as input; **third**, as institution that is assigned to stabilize state values; **fourth**, entering into cooperation with any institutions of equal level both in the home country and overseas.

The Governor informed the performance target of this year of among others giving knowledge such as state insight, national alertness, national awareness toward strategic environment developing dynamically either nationally, regionally or globally, and knowledge to think systematically with comprehensive, integral and holistic approach.

DR. Hj. R. Adjeng Ratna Suminar, S.H., M.M, said as an alumnus of Lemhannas, Lemhannas has superiority as educational institution since there is science maintaining

state sovereignty, which can further be used and very helpful in applying herself as member of DPR RI.

The Governor of Lemhannas RI also said that Lemhannas RI had accomplished Regular Education Program (PPRA) of Group XLIV which ended in early October, while PPRA XLV is still on going. Besides, there is a Consolidation Forum (Forkon) of Regent, Mayor, and Speaker of DPRD of Group IV and Indonesia Municipal Councils Association (ADEKSI) for members of District People’s House of Representatives and Municipal People’s House of Representatives in the framework of stabilization of state values. Lemhannas RI also makes strategic researches as formulated through roundtable discussion either in politics, economics, socio-culture, defense and security, or international relations of which the findings shall be forwarded to President of the Republic of Indonesia.

Meanwhile the Professor of IPB, Prof. DR. Rio Mendung Thalieb, and continued with discussion with professional personnel of Lemhannas RI namely Major General Pandji Soesilo, DR. Rosita S. Noor, M.A., and Ir. Timotius D. Harsono, M.Sc.

Topic that came up in the discussion was about the relationship between Indonesia and China which is getting closer particularly after Asean-China Free Trade Agreement (ACFTA). In the discussion, the group of Chinese People's Liberation Army (CPLA) raised questions about the role of Lemhannas RI, and difference between resilience and defense of Indonesia, education system of PPRA and strategy and political and economic policy direction of China and Indonesia.

Further, Lemhannas RI confirms that Defense and Resilience are two different terms. National resilience includes eight determinant aspects, which are geography, demography, natural resources (*tri gatra*) and ideology, politics, economy, social and culture as well as defence and

security (*panca gatra*). Meanwhile, defense and security are parts of nasional resilience aimed at protecting the state in terms physical aspects. The group CPLA Command Academy also questions the strategy adopted by the government of Indonesia to increase people's welfare, namely by focusing on development and security. Challenge encountered by Indonesia at present is liberal politic and economic policy, of which Indonesia should protect domestic industry. China also encounter some challenges, namely by effectiveness of open policy of Chinese Government, namely by balancing the liberal economic policy and socialist political system. Problem encountered by China at present is how to fulfill food and basic necessities for Chinese population totaling 1.33 billion persons.

In the discussion, the speakers from Lemhannas RI raised questions about policy of Government of China which prefers to invest its capital in the United States of America, and not in Indonesia, while by applying the same amount of capital in Indonesia, the investor of China will get more profit. The speaker expects that relation between Indonesia and China is not only beneficial to either party, but it would expectedly be beneficial to both.

The session was ended by exchange of souvenir and was then continued by visiting the class room in Trigatra Building, Floor III East, Library, as well as Telematics bureau of Lemhannas RI.
