



SCIENTIFIC ORATION OF LEMHANNAS RI: “NATIONALISM, GLOBALIZATION AND NATIONAL RESILIENCE”

As the peak of the 46th anniversary of Lemhannas RI on May 20, 2011 Lemhannas RI organized a Scientific Oration that was held after the Parade Ceremony in the central courtyard of Lemhannas RI. The Scientific Oration was held in the Dwiwarna Purwa building, and was attended by the Secretary of Governing Board, the First secretary, the Structural Officials of Lemhannas RI and the other invitees. Acting as an orator was Fachry Ali, a socio-political observer from LIPI, with the scientific oration titled “Nationalism, Globalization and National Resilience” which is very relevant to the current conditions in Indonesia.

At the event, the Governor of Lemhannas RI Prof. Dr. Ir. Budi Susilo Soepandji, D.E.A. conveyed a keynote speech stating that Lemhannas RI, entering its 46 years of age, has made a lot of contribution and achievement. They have affected the state of the national resilience in various aspects. THE XXVII CONSOLIDATION OF NATIONAL VALUES, CONCEPTION AND LEADERSHIP FOR SPEAKERS AND MEMBERS OF THE REGIONAL LEGISLATIVE COUNCILS (DPRD) AND REGIONAL GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS

The national values, which were strongly awakened during the colonial times, are now somewhat disturbed, and show a declining trend in the life of the people and of the nation. This is evident with the emergence of various regional conflicts in the country. In this regard, in order to rebuild a sense of nationhood, the Deputy for the Consolidation of National Values of Lemhannas RI, in accordance with its main duties and functions, held an event “the XXVII Consolidation of National Values, Conception and Leadership for Speakers and Members of the Regional Legislative Council (DPRD) and Local Government Officials in 2011 for 7 days in Lemhannas RI.

Prof. Dr. Ir. Budi Susilo Soepandji, D.E.A., as the Governor of Lemhannas RI, opened the event on May 23, 2011 at the Dwiwarna Purwa Building. It was attended by Secretary of the Governing Board, First Secretary, Deputies, Expert Lecturers, Expert Analysts, Expert Professionals, General Chairman of ADEKSI and its management staff and other invitees. In his opening speech, Governor of Lemhannas RI conveyed that the rapid change in the strategic environment requires quality national leadership that is capable of bringing this nation to achieve the national goals through the stages of programmed, focused and sustainable development. Besides, in order to keep

up with the global development, the Indonesia’s human resources should be able to master the technology and have a high competitiveness. Those two factors are very beneficial for the development and management of the national economy in order to provide a conducive climate to build “knowledge capital” of a nation.

Governor of Lemhannas RI conveyed that the activity is a part of national consolidation. It is also one of Lemhannas RI’s efforts in providing a dialogic enlightenment. By giving the core teaching materials of Lemhannas RI to the participants, it is expected that they will be able to, first, think systematically and comprehensively, integrally and holistically, for the national interests within the framework of the unitary state of the Republic of Indonesia, second, develop anticipatory, cooperative and synergic attitude for the interests of the people; third, care about the potentials owned by the regions and promote regional self-reliance; fourth, be committed to the sustainability of the national development which guarantees the peace and public order as well as people’s welfare. Besides that, the governor also hoped for all the participants of the consolidation of national values to implement the four basic national consensus into the life of the people in the regions.

MINISTER OF DEFENCE'S LECTURE TO THE XVII PPSA PARTICIPANTS: STATE DEFENSE POLICY AND STRATEGY IN THE FRAMEWORK OF NATIONAL RESILIENCE

The XVII PPSA participants received a lecture from the Minister of Defence, Ir. Purnomo Yusgiantoro, M.Sc., M.A., Ph.D. on May 23, 2011 in the West Wing of the 3rd Floor, Trigatra Building. The Defence Minister gave a lecture on the topic “**State Defense Policy and Strategy in the framework of National Resilience**”.

In his lecture the Defence Minister gave an explanation on the State Defense Policy and Strategy, which are a key driver to create national resilience and protect the national interests. He also touched on principle of the primary defense weapon system development.

The defence minister also conveyed a few things regarding the procurement of primary defense weapon system, first, domestic production must be prioritized over foreign production; second, when the the primary defense weapon system is procured from abroad, it must be conducted through government-to-government program, and joint production as well as technology transfer must be sought while the unimpeded usage and availability of spare parts be guaranteed; third, the procurement of the primary defense weapon system follows a tiered process (users and policy makers). Related to the above, in order to

achieve the defense industry goals, the ministry of defense has made the roadmap 2010-2029 with the target to meet the demand of domestic market (short term) and to compete at the global level (long term).

The roadmap is divided into 4 phases, **first**, 2010-2014, setting the programs, stabilizing and optimizing the defense industry, preparing defense industry regulation and new future products; **second**, 2015-2019, supporting the Minimum Essential Forces (MEF) of TNI, building

cooperation in production capability, and developing new products; **third**, 2020-2024, supporting the ideal posture of the TNI, developing the industry (medium-term products), and improving international cooperation (new product development, advanced technology); **fourth**, 2025-2029, building a significant self-reliance in the defense industry (to be quantified), the ability to collaborate internationally (international sales), and sustainable development.

TNI COMMANDER-IN-CHIEF'S LECTURE TO THE PPSA XVII PARTICIPANTS: POLICIES AND STRATEGIES OF TNI IN ASSUMING ITS ROLES AND FUNCTIONS IN THE FRAMEWORK OF NATIONAL RESILIENCE

On May 24, 2011, the TNI Commander-in-Chief Admiral Agus Suhartono gave a lecture to the participants PPSA XVII in the West Wing of the 3rd Floor, Trigatra Building, with the theme "The TNI Policy and Strategy in Assuming Its Roles and Functions in the framework of National Resilience". Early in his speech he revealed the TNI missions in 2011, which are to maintain the sovereignty and integrity of the Unitary State of the Republic of Indonesia as well as the security of the nation and also to develop the strength, capability and deployment of forces in order to meet its "Minimum Essential Force (MEF)." It was also explained that the Unitary State of the Republic of Indonesia (NKRI) is facing military and nonmilitary threats.

However, the TNI Commander-in-Chief affirmed that irregardless of the situation and condition, the TNI must always be prepared to face any threats in order to maintain the integrity and sovereignty of the Unitary State of the Republic of Indonesia as well as the security of the nation. The reason is that there are five important points from the mandate of the Great Commander

General Sudirman on June 7, 1946 that are inherent in the spirit of the TNI, namely, **first**, to believe in own power, **second**, to continue your struggle, many have fallen victim; **third**, to defend our home and grounds; **fourth**, our troops will never surrender to those who would colonize us again; fifth, to hold on to the discipline of the military wholeheartedly.

Regarding the TNI policy and strategy, the TNI Commander-in-Chief talked about a variety of TNI

policies and strategies that have been established and implemented, such as the TNI capacity and capability development policy, TNI force development and deployment policy, TNI force utilization policy, TNI internal reform and bureaucracy policy, TNI role optimization policy, TNI's soldiers and civil servants welfare policy, administrative supervision and rule policy, zero growth and right sizing policy, foreign relations and international cooperation policy.

COORDINATION MEETING ON NATIONALISTIC VIEWPOINT

Governor of Lemhannas RI Prof. Dr. Ir. Budi Susilo Soepandji, D.E.A. attended the Coordination Meeting on the Strategy to Maintain and Strengthen National Integrity, Patriotism, State Defence as the Implementation of Pancasila, as one of the speakers. The event was organized by the Deputy VI for the Coordination of National Unity on 31 May 2011 in the Meeting Room, 6th Floor Building A, Coordinating Ministry for Politics, Law and Security.

The coordination meeting is an effort to maintain and strengthen the national integrity, patriotism and state defence that are important for Indonesia. It was attended by officials of echelon I, II and III of the Coordinating Minister for Politics, Law and Security

as well as representatives from the Ministry of Home Affairs, Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Ministry of Defence, Ministry of Culture and Tourism, Ministry of Religious Affairs, Ministry of National Education, Bappenas, Wantannas, Lemhannas RI, and Baintelkam Polri. It was explained in the meeting that values the nationalistic viewpoint must be nourished in a planned, organized and focused manner at all levels of society. Such views refer to the 1945 Constitution, Law No. 3 of 2002 on National Defence, Law No. 20 of 2003 on National Education System, and Law No. 39 of 1999 on Human Rights.

The Governor of Lemhannas RI conveyed that the theme is very

appropriate, given that the concept of nationalistic viewpoint is a very important factor for the continuation of the life of a nation and state, especially for the highly heterogeneous Indonesia. Therefore, a comprehensive effort by all national components is needed in order to enhance such a concept, among others, by maintaining and strengthening the national integrity, patriotism, and state defence. It is also conveyed that in order to achieve national goals that have been established and to ensure its continuation, the Indonesian people must have a strong concept of nationalistic viewpoint to be implemented in the life of the people and of the nation. The nationalistic viewpoint of the Indonesian people can be in the form of spirit of unity, nationalism and state defence. Therefore, the manifestation of the nationalistic viewpoint should be implemented in government, politics, economics, socio culture, defense and security, which is based on the strength of the national ideology of Pancasila.

The Governor of Lemhannas RI asserted that the efforts to raise awareness for state defence (which includes the spirit of unity, patriotism and state defence) are the responsibility of all components of the nation, both the government and non-governmental institutions, as well as the community. Therefore, a synergy of all national components needs to be built in an effort to maintain and strengthen the people's awareness for state defence in order to ensure the continuation of the life of the people and of the nation.

A Discussion to Commemorate the Birth of Pancasila in Lemhannas RI: REVITALIZING PANCASILA VALUES IN ORDER TO STRENGTHEN THE UNITY AMONG THE NATIONAL COMPONENTS THROUGH A DIALOGUE FORUM IN THE FRAMEWORK OF NATIONAL RESILIENCE

On order to celebrate the birth of Pancasila on June 1, 1965, Lemhannas RI held a discussion with the theme “Revitalizing Pancasila Values in Order to Strengthen Unity among the National Components through a Dialogue Forum in the Framework of National Resilience”. The discussion held on May 31, 2011 in the West Wing of the 3rd Floor, Astagatra Building was opened by the Governor of Lemhannas RI Prof. Dr. Ir. Budi Susilo Soepandji, D.E.A., and was attended by the Secretary of the Governing Board, First Secretary, Deputies, Speakers and Panelists, Expert Lecturers, Expert Analysts, Expert Professionals, and other invitees.

In his keynote speech, Governor of Lemhannas RI conveyed that the discussion is considered as highly strategic, and is therefore prioritized to be analyzed. Pancasila is now experiencing a degradation of values in its implementation that can threaten its existence as a fundamental law of the state. Various studies show that the efforts to understand and implement Pancasila values through a sustainable social learning process has been declining. Therefore, it is necessary to develop a learning method that involves all national components productively in the form of an interactive forum for dialogue and exemplary embodiment of Pancasila in everyday life. Based on the

study activities of Lemhannas RI that have been conducted in the study field, the society has demanded the government to redevelop social learning regarding Pancasila values. Apparently, there is a longing for the efforts that had been developed in the past. As the values of Pancasila are increasingly degraded, it is hoped that the learning can be developed through an interactive learning process involving various national components through a dialogue, so that the values of local wisdom can be absorbed in the framework of the Unitary State with the Diversity.

The Governor of Lemhannas RI also conveyed that as one of the main pillars of national paradigm in the life of the people and of the nation, Pancasila has become one of the principal parts in the conception of national resilience. There is hope from various national components for Lemhannas RI to take an active role through the Strengthening Program of National Values. Therefore, Governor of Lemhannas RI hoped that this study can formulate the learning pattern in the formation of national characters by accommodating the values of social wisdom in an integral manner. It is hoped that other than enlightening, the learning process can also empower the people in addressing problems, according to the cultural roots which have served as an underlying cause in the strengthening of Pancasila.

The event was attended by the Secretary of Governing Board, First Secretary, Deputies, Expert Lecturers, Expert Analysts, Expert Professionals and structural officials of Lemhannas RI.

The Coffee Morning event was opened by the Governor of Lemhannas RI Prof. Dr. Ir. Budi Susilo Soepandji, D.E.A., and was attended by two resource persons from the University of Diponegoro University Prof. Dr. Ir. Sugiono Soetomo, D.E.A., and the Director General of Spatial Planning from the Ministry of Public Works Ir. Imam S. Ernawi, MCM, M.Sc. The first presentation was made by Prof. Dr. Ir. Sugiono Soetomo, D.E.A., with the theme “Spatial Management and Regional Development Politics”. In his presentation, it was conveyed that the management (planning, utilization, and control) is a development policy in spatial dimensions within the realm of politics (national territory, regency/municipality). It was also said that the regional development politics is a power in setting the

development decision in all sectors within the domain of power/politics.

The second presentation was given by Ir. Imam S. Ernawi, MCM, M.Sc. from the Ministry of Public Works. He discussed about the “Operation of Spatial Planning”. In his explanation he conveyed that given the available space and the number and needs of growing populations, a spatial management is required (managing the space and utilizing the natural resources contained comprehensively and integratively as well as tools for regional development) in order to create a national space which is safe, comfortable, productive and sustainable. In addition, infrastructure, which is a key element in spatial management, also serves as a basis for the integrated development of infrastructure and settlements in the framework of sustainable development. It was also conveyed that by looking at the current issues and challenges, the implementation of spatial planning is needed in order to ensure the optimization of the national space utilization for all the stakeholders by addressing the gap between regions, responding to environmental problems and sustainable development issues, as well as ensuring the integrity of the nation.

HEARING BETWEEN LEMHANNAS RI AND COMMISSION I OF DPR RI

Lemhannas RI had a hearing with the Commission I of the House of Representatives (DPR) on June 8, 2011 in the Meeting Room of Commission I of DPR RI. Present at the hearing was Governor of Lemhannas RI Prof. Dr. Ir. Budi Susilo Soepandji, D.E.A. who was accompanied by Secretary of Governing Board, First Secretary, along with the structural officials of Lemhannas RI. At the hearing the Governor gave his explanation on the Lemhannas RI's Work Plan of the Ministry / Institution (RKA KL) and the Government Work Plan (RKP KL) for the 2012 Fiscal Year which was oriented to the tasks and functions of Lemhannas RI according to the Presidential Decree Number 67 of 2006 dated 13 June 2006 on Lemhannas RI.

It was also conveyed that the preparation of program and budget plan in Lemhannas RI was done by using the program and budget structure based on prevailing regulations, and was implemented using a bottom-up approach. Therefore, the program and budget plan was based on the suggestion of each work unit. Based on the joint circular of the Minister for National Development Planning/Head of National Development Planning Agency and the Minister of Finance No. 0091/M.PPN/03/2011, SE-189.1/MK/2011 dated March 31, 2011 concerning the indicative ceiling and Preliminary Draft of the 2012 Government Work Plan (RKP), Lemhannas RI, for the fiscal year 2012, receives a budget of Rp. 190,759,900,000,-.

Furthermore, on 8 April 2011, a trilateral meeting was held between Lemhannas RI, Bappenas and Ministry of Finance to discuss Indicative Ceilings issues based on on the scale of priorities in order to support program and activity plan that has been compiled and aligned with the 2012 RKP priorities. It includes three program: first, the program for the management support and implementation of other technical tasks of Lemhannas RI; second, the program to increase the supervision and accountability of the apparatus of Lemhannas RI; third, the program to develop national resilience program. If the allocation of the 2011 budget of Lemhannas RI which amounts to Rp

190,350,000,000,- is compared to the indicative ceiling of Lemhannas RI for the year 2012 of Rp. 190,759,900,000,- there is an increase of Rp 409.9 million or 0.21%.

The Governor of Lemhannas RI conveyed that according to the priority activities for the year 2012 (Lemhannas RI's 2010-2014 Strategic Plan) of Rp. 354,047,664,500,-, with reference to an indicative ceiling of Lemhannas RI for the year 2012, then it is still experiencing a shortage of Rp 163,287,764,500,-. Therefore, Lemhannas RI hoped that the Commission I would seek to have Lemhannas RI's 2012 budget need fulfilled.
