



Interview with Governor of Lemhannas RI



Prof. DR. Muladi, S.H., in an interview with journalist from Mimbar Politik Magazine

On February 11, 2010, the Governor of Lemhannas RI, Prof. DR. Muladi, S.H., on the sidelines of his busy schedule, gave an interview with a journalist from a political magazine in Jakarta. The Governor of Lemhannas was interviewed at his office. The topic of interview was about the issue of weak law enforcement, rendering indication of the reason why foreign investors are not quite interested in making investment in Indonesia. In a democratic country, if talking about good governance, then there will be 3 pillars namely: **first**, state pillar; **second**, role of private sector; **third**, civil society. Therefore, the state, in its development, can no longer stand on its own. It is because the private sector also plays an important role, especially in civil society sector.

All of them are closely related to condition of our law-based country which is still far from satisfactory, let alone practices occurring recently, for example Bank Century case, followed by judicial mafia. In addition, there are also corruption cases involving members of DPR (People's House of Representatives), DPRD (Provincial House of Representatives), Mayor, and District Head, as well as Governor, even ex-ministers. The said condition has become our great concern. Further the Governor of Lemhannas RI said that the measure taken by the President by stipulating it as issue that should be paid attention to, is very appropriate. So that, to improve quality of law based country the Governor of Lemhannas said that there are 3 important things namely: **first**, Building good organization structure, including its Human Resources, since human is main system of organization structure; **second**, Substantive matters and legislation products, since any things really identifying on what to revise from the said Legislation should be learned through; **third**, cultural issue, since culture is a point of view, value, perception, building

a good bureaucratic reform, relating to state apparatus. This third out of the three points is causing more concern, since a culture of the end justifies the means still frequently happened in Indonesia. Therefore, we need tough, credible, strong and unadorned persons in leading law institutions, either Chief Police, Attorney General, Chief Justice of the Supreme Court, and Chief of Constitutional Court of Justice.

Further, the Governor of Lemhannas RI said that criminal judicial system in all lines are still become focus of public attention, particularly Police, Attorney General, and also the Supreme Court and Judicial Institution lines. The Governor of Lemhannas RI explains that if we talk about source of corruption, the following formula can be used:

$$C = M + D - A$$

Where:

C = Corruption

M = Man namely official granted with monopoly of power, such as Prosecutor, Judge,

D = Discretion namely official having authority to take any measures allowable by Legislation.

A = Accountability

Such as in criminal case of thievery which shall be subject to imprisonment of 1 through 4 years, the judge may, based on legal consideration and his/her belief, pass imprisonment of 1 day or more from 1 day to a maximum of 4 years, and A = Accountability, namely person any person who is granted with monopoly of power and authority to determine wide scope of discretion, but not relating to accountability, since accountability will only be responsible to one's self, society and state, while the Judge will, in addition to be responsible to him/her self, also be responsible to God.

Urgency of Revising Law Number 32 of 2004 Regarding Decentralization

Roundtable discussion (RTD) with a theme of “Urgency of Revising Law Number 32 of 2004 regarding Decentralization in the Context of Regional Head Election to support the Implementation of National Management System in Region in the Framework of Stabilizing National Resilience” was convened on February 16, 2010 in Nusantara Room I Trigatra, Lemhannas RI.

The Governor of Lemhannas RI, Prof. Dr. Muladi, S.H., opens the discussion and gives his viewpoint in relation to urgency of revising Law No. 32 of 2004. This theme needs to be the first priority to study, since it has strategic values as the effort aiming at improving public service and prosperity. Discussion of law also requires partial and comprehensive viewpoint to obtain full description on substance of regional head election, as well as avoid misinterpretation in regard to the legislation.

According to the Governor of Lemhannas RI, the policy of decentralization in the context of establishment of autonomous region will be the appropriate choice, particularly to improve efficiency and effectiveness of government supervision and service. Since the beginning, the founders of Indonesia fully realize that the Indonesian Government can not be managed by centralization, but the implementation of Regional Head Election (Pilkada) which is all these times full of conflict, suit each other, event inter-group conflict would be an indication of importance to discuss the same due to frequent misinterpretation in the implementation of law regarding arrangement of Regional Head Election. The Regional Head Election which is actually needed to encourage democratic culture is failed to be democratic propagation. Regional Head Election process has resulted in various issues, starting from efficiency issue to effectiveness of government administration

in region. The Governor also added that “position of governor as representative of government in region has not yet functioned well, so that the government management system is not effective, let alone if it is related to behavior of district head or mayor in the mechanism of regional development coordination”.

Grand design in revision of Law No. 32 of 2004 has placed democracy as an effort of fulfillment of civil rights to participate in development process so that manifestation of Indonesian democracy should be formulated comprehensively in the national resilience context.

There are some factors that should be paid attention in the revision context; **first**, representative deliberative principles in democratic context and Regional Head Election mechanism; **second**, position of government agency including relation between regional head and DPRD (Provincial House of Representatives); **third**, inter-government agencies work mechanism (central-regional) and stakeholders; **fourth**, leadership capacity and competency in the application of National Management System and apparatus competency; **fifth**, profit sharing pattern between central and provincial government and management of provincial revenue sources; **sixth**, planning mechanism and development policy which is integrated and sustainable; and **seventh**, relation between regional stability and national vigilance and national resilience.

From the said RTD, the Governor expects that the study can give alternative relevant to democratization frame in the decentralization and autonomy process which shall be subject to recommendation of policy to the government and may support implementation of national management system in region. It is made to stabilize the national resilience as well as improve public service and wealth.

The Governor of Lemhannas RI, Prof. Dr. Muladi, S.H., in the opening session on Stabilization of National Values on February 15, 2010 in Dwi Warna Purwa Building of Lemhannas RI, said that stabilization of this national values is one of the efforts to strengthen democratic development or democratic consolidation, so that the democracy will not only be procedural in nature, but also substantial in nature, and it is not only transactional, but also transformational in nature in the interest of state and nation.

Role of Regional Head and DPRD as element of public leadership in region, is a very strategic element to attain the objective, therefore, it is the leadership principle in critical period that should be paid attention, namely collegiality principle which shall mean always working harmoniously; strong commitment to perform any decision already adopted; persistence, being always vigorous and diligent to always do the best in encountering constraint authenticity in building government network; sense of pride as public official by continuously maintaining public values of state administration or pursuant to Good Governance principle; and heroism to perform anything completely and comprehensively.

Stabilization of national values itself as a part of democratic consolidation is principally an effort to give illumination dialogically.

Regarding the participants, they are expected to be able to think systematically and comprehensively for national interest; encourage anticipative, cooperative, synergic attitude toward people interest, paying attention to potency owned by region and build regional independence, as well as commitment to survival of national development securing public tranquility as well as people prosperity.

PRELIMINARY BRIEFING OF AUDIT OF BPK RI ON FINANCIAL STATEMENT OF LEMHANNAS RI

Having the main function to audit the management and responsibility of state finance, the State Audit Board of the Republic of Indonesia (BPK RI) conducted audit on National Resilience Institute of the Republic of Indonesia (Lemhannas RI), on February 17, 2010. "Every audit team of BPK has the significant responsibility to perform state tasks to further report the same to people through legislative institution." That is all initial welcoming speech of the Governor of Lemhannas RI, Prof. DR. Muladi, S.H., in the preliminary briefing session of audit BPK RI in Meeting Room of Nusantara I Trigatra of Lemhannas RI.

The Governor expects that the auditing team and institution or work unit which is audited can work together to secure and enforce independence and professionalism of auditing institution. It should also be paid attention, in the framework of materializing accountability of appropriate state financial management, as the characteristic of Good Governance.

In such occasion, the Governor has also described revitalization of organization and reformation of bureaucracy that is being performed by Lemhannas RI, such as development program of National Resilience Measurement Laboratory (Labkurtannas) and other programs which are based on Information and Communication Technology.

In the application of budget, the Head of Lemhannas RI shall exert its best to improve budget control as contained in terms of Implementing Regulation of Program and Budget; evaluation on implementation of activity and budget through management meeting; implementation of internal supervision by Inspectorate; or evaluation or monitoring made by the Board of Directors through internal meeting. This repair is also made to improve performance accountability of the institution and make Lemhannas RI as center of excellence of the similar institution at Regional or International level.

Governor of Lemhannas RI, Prof. Dr. Muladi, S.H. in Flag-Raising Ceremony on February 17, 2010 stated some matters and his expectation particularly those relating to improvement and implementation of work program, namely:

First, relating to audit by State Audit Board of the Republic of Indonesia (BPK RI). National Resilience Agency of the Republic of Indonesia earned predicate of Reasonable Opinion without exception in 2007 and 2008, the Governor expected that every work unit can cooperate in controlling budget and also in performing work program, in order to be able to show performance optimization, either qualitatively and quantitatively, so that the Lemhannas RI can re-earn predicate of stabilized Reasonable Opinion without exception in 2009.

Second, in relation to bureaucratic reform program in order that the integrated team of Lemhannas RI will accelerate bureaucratic reform administration process which is being developed appropriately.

Third, PPRA XLIV is currently performing remote education program or off campus for three months by using e-learning facility. While on March 9 to April 15, 2010, the Lemhannas RI will organize the regional head consolidation forum consisting of the district head, mayor, and the speaker of DPRD of kabupaten (regency) and kota (municipality).

Fourth, Deputy of Strategic Research Division convened Roundtable discussion (RTD), among others: February 18, 2010, the Directorate of Socio-Culture Research performed RTD with a theme of “**Policy on Improvement of National Examination Organization to Determine Graduation of Student and Mapping of Education Quality in Indonesia which is based on Science and Technology, in the framework of Stabilizing Competitiveness in Regional and Global Arena**” and February 23, 2010, the Directorate of Research of Politic Sector conducted RTD with a theme of “**Resistance against the Plan of Organizing Regional Head Election of 2010, to maintain Stability of security, in the framework of strengthening National Resilience**”.

Fifth, organization of activity of Deputy of Stabilization of National Values, among others: on February 8-12, 2010 organized national education and training of HIPMI of group I, and February 15-19, 2010 and training on stabilization of national values, national conception, and leadership to members of DPRD (Provincial House of Representatives) associated in Adeksi (Association of Municipal Provincial House of Representatives throughout Indonesia). Then on February 22-25, 2010 activity of stabilization of national values to heads of division head level or Head of Office, Executive Body of Petroleum Upstream Operation (BP Migas).

Socialization on Application of Financial Statement of Lemhannas RI

Bureau for Planning and Finance of Lemhannas RI, made socialization on Application of Reporting of Lemhannas RI on March 10, 2010 in Tri Gatra Building, Floor III west. This socialization is made as a follow-up of Government Regulation No. 39 of 2006 regarding Procedure for Control and Evaluation of Development Plan Implementation, as well as form of reporting evaluation on development plan implementation from the Ministry of National Development Plan.

Bureau for Planning and Finance has on the occasion socialized the appropriate mechanism of reporting. Further, Lemhannas RI draws up five forms of report: first, Action Program Report, submitted and audited by BPKP and BPK; second, Program Consolidation Report, submitted and examined by Bappenas; third, Analysis and Evaluation Report, submitted and examined by BPKP and BPK, fourth, LAKIP, submitted and examined by the Ministry for the Supervision of State Apparatus and Bureaucratic Reformation; fifth, Accounting Report, submitted and audited by the Ministry of Finance and BPKP.

In the said occasion, constraints of financial statement which already happened all these times in Lemhannas RI was also described, namely **first**, delay in submission of financial statement from work unit of Lemhannas RI; **second**, lack of comprehension of work unit in developing financial statement; **third**, submission of financial report has

not yet become a part of activity/sub-activity; **Fourth**, non appointment of official to develop financial statement.

In order to support smooth implementation of reporting on development activity plan supported by the use of application, then revision to application already published since 2008 will be made. Some amendments to application of Government Regulation No.39/2006 for version of 2010, among others: **first**, improvement of data basis structure; **second**, addition of sub-activity digit; **third**, Adjustment of data reference following the document of DIPA of 2010; **fourth**, change of appearance of application; **fifth**, change of appearance result of printed report, while type of printed file should be still in .xml format.

Implementation of report of Government Regulation No. 39 of 2006 indicates that there are some evaluations, namely from fund sector, in some work unit, there is no allocation of monitor and evaluation budget (monev); monev team, in this sector the total number of personnel in general is not enough compared to total activities that should be monitored and evaluated; time of reporting; format of reporting, namely it is found that some work units develop report using varied format or not conforming to standard or still frequently empty; as well as indicator and objectivity, the problems that arose such as implementation of monitoring is still considered as routine activity and no follow up.

Resistance against the Plan of organizing Regional Head Election of 2010

On February 23, 2010, the Governor of Lemhannas RI, Prof. DR. Muladi, S.H., conveyed his keynote speech in Roundtable Discussion session. Strategic study with a topic of “Resistance against Plan of organizing Regional Head Election of 2010 to maintain Stability of Security in the framework of strengthening National Resilience”, in Meeting Room of Nusantara I, Trigatra Building.

Since 2005-2008, there were 476 areas in Indonesia have organized regional head election, and there were 210 cases of dispute arising in the Regional Head Election are resolved through court. To Governor, dispute resolution in regional head election through the court constitutes evidence of conflict and security disturbance as the result of organizing regional head election.

In his welcoming speech, the Governor mentioned that the cause of conflict in the regional head election was among others due to inaccuracy of data of Fixed Electors List (DPT); ballot box distribution; mobilization of elector; vote bloating; and money politics. People choosing to be group of abstainers from voting or illegal ballot were alleged to be the trigger of resistance against the regional head election implementation.

Conflict accumulation occurring during regional head election has also triggered the thought to resist toward the regional head election organization in the future, although it is a political and social dynamicity. “However, the conflict occurring in various areas should not be generalized

increase quality of regional head election quality so as to minimize conflict,” the Governor added.

Taking into account many conflicts that have occurred during the regional head election, the Governor of Lemhannas RI gave the following inputs to be discussed, namely:

First, organizing regional head election appropriately and democratically, and not causing any conflict or disturbance of Community Safety and Law and Order that will deteriorate regional resilience;

Second, regional head election constitutes implementation of people sovereignty in region based on Pancasila and 1945 Constitution of the Republic of Indonesia.

Third, how to create system which is effective and efficient to stakeholders of regional head election (KPU (Regional General Election Commission), political party, candidate, success team, and so on) so that people can accept the organization of regional head election;

Fourth, how to increase people participation in organizing the regional head election to minimize group of society who are not using their voting rights, so as to increase legitimacy of elected regional head.

Fifth, how to minimize or reduce cost in every regional head election.

STABILIZATION OF NATIONAL VALUES TO DIVISION HEAD/EQUIVALENT OF BP MIGAS AND LEADERS OF STAKEHOLDERS

Stabilization of Indonesian national values as consolidating means of national unity of Indonesia has developed since growth of national awareness which is pluralistic in the heart of young generation of Indonesia, not only upon proclamation of independence on August 17, 1945, but far before it namely on May 20, 1908 and October 28, 1928, being monumental historical event in the history of the Republic of Indonesia.

The Governor of Lemhannas RI, Prof.DR. Muladi, S.H., reminded the same to Division Head and Equivalent of BP Migas and leader of stakeholders when participating in the program of stabilization of national values opened by the Governor of Lemhannas RI on Monday, February 22, 2010 in Lemhannas RI.

Togetherness in one nation, one language, one state, to Indonesian nation which is very pluralistic should be built based on objective and non-primordialistic values.

Executive Body of Petroleum Upstream Operation (BP Migas) as institution entrusted by the government to manage natural assets of Indonesia, plays a very strategic role in giving contribution to state revenue to finance development to attain security and prosperity of Indonesian people. By the

performance of stabilization of national values to division head/equivalent as well as to partners and stakeholders relating to BP Migas, being real effort to perform transformation of behavior and moral of leadership in line with guidance on good governance and clean government, toward state identity, so as to be able to combine national interest, either central or provincial government interests rationally with orientation and objective to make all of Indonesian people prosperous.

At the end of his welcoming speech, the Governor of Lemhannas RI said that in paying attention to challenge of Indonesian nation in the future and to eliminate some wrong perceptions of a part of group toward noble values of Pancasila, 1945 Constitution, principle of the Unitary State of the Republic of Indonesia and the spirit of unity in diversity, then the program of stabilization of national values to officials within strategic institution such as BP Migas, Vice President, cooperating contractors, and leader of stakeholders has become very relevant to be performed in order to be more motivating and increasing high nationalism so as to strengthen national resilience. By this stabilization, the participants are expected to be able to think systematically and comprehensively, integrally for national interest in the framework of the Unitary State of the Republic of Indonesia; encourage responsive, anticipative, cooperative, synergetic attitude toward the interest of people; being concerned to potency owned by region and develop regional independence as well as commitment to survival of national development securing prosperity, democracy, and justice in the framework of good governance.

Preparatory Meeting of Welcoming the Visit of Obama to Indonesia

In March 11, 2010 in the meeting room of Nusantara I, Tri Gatra Building of Lemhannas RI, a preparatory meeting was held in the framework of visit of President of the United States of America, Barack Obama, to Indonesia to deliver a public lecture in Jakarta.

The meeting attended by among others Rector of the University of Indonesia, Governor of the Lemhannas RI, chairperson of AIPI, Secretary of Governing Board, Chief Secretary, Director General of Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Indonesia, with three American representatives from White House in Washington and from the Embassy of the United States of America in Jakarta, discussing technical matters relating to the said activity plan.

The representative from the United States of America gave appreciation to the organizing committee for support already given, and both side committed to making this visit as an extraordinary visit. Public lecture by the President of the United States of America, Barack Obama would be one of important programs.

Regarding the objective to be conveyed in the public lecture, namely Unity in Diversity, the United States of

America said that they would openly invite Indonesian people as many as possible from various levels. It was warmly welcomed by chairperson of the organizing committee saying that Indonesian people have been waiting for this occasion, due to appreciation to background of the President of the United States of America, Barack Obama who had ever lived for some years in Indonesia in his childhood. Besides, it was also conveyed by one of the representatives from the US that Obama has missed to "come home".

In the meeting, some technical issues were discussed relating to the visit, which include, among others access and transportation means, socialization of visit agenda, security as well as entertaining program for the visitors who are expected to come in a large number. Therefore, the organizing committee needs to prepare and plan the event appropriately and properly ranging from arrival of visitors and queuing, or when they listen to public lecture, and leave the location.

At the end of session, the Director General of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Indonesia confirmed that there would be no introduction remark by the President of the Republic of Indonesia in the program.

Policy on Improvement of National Examination Organization quality

Governor of Lemhannas RI, Prof.DR. Muladi, S.H., in his Keynote Speech in Roundtable Discussion on Strategic study over “Policy on Improvement of National Examination Organization quality, to determine graduation of Student and Mapping of Educational Quality in Indonesia based on Science and Technology, in the framework of stabilizing Competitiveness in Regional and Global Territory,” stated that national examination organization has historically a weakness, due to difficulty to measure and map the educational quality nationally, finally, policy on national examination was issued in 2002 which can expectedly be used to regulate graduation system and simultaneously measure and map the educational quality nationally.

In its development, society urges the government to review national education system and also improve teacher’s quality, education facility and infrastructure, as well as information, particularly in rural areas. People worries that national examination becomes a form of serious violation against Human Rights (HAM) of students, as well as review the national education system by revising Government Regulation Number 19 of 2005 regarding Education National Standard.

In such occasion, the Governor mentioned some strategic steps and analysis that need to be considered in organizing fair and credible national examination, among others:

First, preventing fraud in the implementation of national examination by government apparatus including principal, supervisor and teacher.

Second, engaging various components of society including educational committee and school committee to jointly support the implementation of fair and credible national

examination.

Third, providing facility center to handle any issue of national examination in every Provincial Police throughout Indonesia.

Fourth, necessity to handle psychological burden to any students by giving opportunity of re-examination to any students who failed in the first examination, distribution of general description on subjects that will be subject to national examination, and policy of students to be able to determine on their own the subjects having score of 5.50 that will be repeated, as well as score in use in determining graduation is the best score and any students who failed in the re-examination will be provided with opportunity to participate in equality examination of A, B, C.

While analysis to national examination that should be made shall be as follows:

First, whether or not the legislation and government regulation have fulfilled education qualification standard according to guidelines on implementation of task professionally.

Second, whether or not education system has already clear objective and direction to improve education quality by having appropriate evaluation.

Third, how the implementation of education management and national education system can integrate ranging from basic education to higher education.
